"DR. OLIVE I. REDDICK SCHOLARSHIP"

1. There shall be a post – graduate scholarship called "***Olive I. Reddick Scholarship****" payable out of the interest of an endowment of ₹ 21,000/- *donated by Indian Fulbright Alumni* in memory of ***Dr. Olive I. Reddick Director, U.S.E.F.I., New Delhi.***
2. a. The Scholarship shall be of the value of ₹ 120/- *p.m.** and shall be awarded every third year to a student pursuing study for M.A. Degree in Economics in the University of Delhi. Any student in receipt of this scholarship shall not be permitted to hold any other scholarship/financial assistance awarded by Delhi University of any other University or by the Central Government, or any State Government or Private Body, except freeship.
b. Merit shall not be the main ^{*criteria*} criterion for the grant of this scholarship, the means of the students shall be regarded as the main factor.
3. The scholarship shall be awarded for a period of two years to a student for pursuing study for the M.A. course in Economics and shall be subject to a satisfactory progress of the student in his studies.
4. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendation of the Selection Committee ~~constituted~~ ^{*constituted*} as follows:-
consisting of:-
 1. The Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences (Chairman)
 2. *The Head, Department of Economics,
 3. One Senior Professor of the Department of Economics
5. Any amount accruing from interest from the endowment, if not spent during any year, shall be added to the Endowment Fund.
6. A report of the award of scholarship will be furnished to the Donor and the U.S.E.F.I., New Delhi each year.
